It appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that you are not likely again to engage in a criminal course of conduct, and that the ends of justice and the welfare of society do not require that you should suffer the penalty authorized by law.

Now, therefore, it is ordered and adjudged that the imposition of sentence is hereby withheld, and that you are hereby placed on probation for a period of 12 Months under the supervision of **Professional Probation Services, Inc.** Probation Office, such supervision to be subject to the provisions of the laws of this State. It is further ordered that you shall comply with the following conditions of probation:

- (1) You will not change your residence or employment or leave the county of your residence without first procuring the consent of your Probation Supervisor.
- (2) Each month, during the period of probation, you will make a full and truthful report in person to your Probation Supervisor, unless otherwise directed by your Probation Supervisor.
- (3) You will neither possess, carry, or own any weapons or firearms without first securing the consent of your Probation Supervisor.
- (4) You will live and remain at liberty without violating any law. A conviction in a court of law shall not be necessary in order for such a violation to constitute a violation of your probation.
- (5) You will not use intoxicants; nor will you visit places where intoxicants, drugs or other dangerous substances are unlawfully sold, dispensed or used unlawfully. You will not use illegal drugs.
- (6) You will work diligently at a lawful occupation and support any dependents to the best of your ability, as directed by your Probation Supervisor.
- (7) You will promptly and truthfully answer all inquiries directed to you by the Court or the Probation Supervisor, and allow the Supervisor to visit in your home, at your employment site or elsewhere, and you will comply with all instructions he or she may give you.
- ☒ (8) You will pay \$ 55 per month toward the cost of this supervision beginning on the date to be set by your Probation Officer.
- ☒ (9) All affirmative conditions of Probation will be completed no later than 30 days prior to completion of your probationary period.

It is further ordered that when you have reported to the Probation Supervisor and have been instructed as to the conditions of probation, you shall be released from custody if you are in custody, and if you are at liberty on bond, the sureties thereon shall stand discharged from liability.

It is further ordered that the Clerk of the Court file this order in his office, and record the same in the Minutes of the Court.
